1. Three Marvelous Dessert Wines – Beerenauslese - each 375 ml

Three different late harvested, handpicked berry-bunches with botrytis-effected grapes lead to craft these remarkable dessert elixirs. Quite rare and profound, their lusciousness tends to capture the essence of “sweet peach, yellow apple and honey notes”. Quite high in residual sugars, they are efforts from estates that trace roots back to 1141 (zu Knyphausen) and 1796 (Valckenberg) as a wine merchant.

2. 1996 Cakebread Cabernet Sauvignon - 1.5 Liter

This is an outstanding mature vintage from this exceptional Napa Valley producer. It’s not often you can find examples with this quality, age, and larger size. “...upfront ripeness and fruitiness...with ripe cherry and blackberry...mildly tannic. Only 9,000 cases made.”

3. The Terraces Winery Napa Valley “Sleepover”

Accommodations for two nights, an off-road four-wheeler tour of the hillside property, and a private tasting with owners/winemaker Timm and Sharon Crull of this fabulous “terraced” Napa estate near St. Helena. It’s a ‘treasured’ visit to a remarkable way to visit “wine country”. If you’re lucky, you’ll visit and taste their vertical of handmade balsamic vinegars...a real treat in itself. This winery produces excellent Zinfandels and Cabernets, in particular.

4. 2005 Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia

So many truly great wines are known by but one name - Latour, Grange, and from Italy - Sassicaia. “Another strong effort...understated, delicate expression of smoke, herbs, tobacco, and sweet dark fruit...compelling harmony and gorgeous...mostly Cabernet with a small amount of Cabernet Franc.” Drink from 2012 until 2025. *93 pts Robert Parker*

5. 2005 Ancien Pinot Noir “Horizontal” Sampling

Five different Pinots from five different vineyard appellations - all from this remarkable ‘artisanal pinot-fanatic winery’ in Napa Valley. Since 1992, they have concentrated on producing Pinot Noir utilizing traditional French barrel fermentation. Each is uniquely different expressing its own terrior and conditions.

6. 2003 Penfolds Grange

One of few names in the wine world that has the prestige of Latour and Lafite - a truly “world class” Shiraz tasting experience. “Supple, ripe and generous with its blueberry, plum, and mocha flavors...rich, complex and evocative...drink now through 2020.”

7. 2001 Jarvis Cabernet Franc – 1.5 liter

A stellar 2001growing season in Napa Valley produced many exceptional wines. Jarvis is considered to have some of the valley’s finest Cabernet Franc vineyards located high up on Atlas Mountain. The wine maker is none other than the son of California’s wine history’s greatest winemaker- Andre Tchelistcheff/son- Demitri. “A toasty vanilla touch from 19 months in Nevers oak adds to the ripe fruit of spicy blueberry and black cherry.”

8. Two 99 Point Shiraz Selections from Australia

A mere one point off perfection for these extraordinary wines. The 2005 Mollydooker Carnival of Love “extraordinary black/purple color, gorgeous notes of blackberry liquor, camphor, and smoke...enormous voluptuousness...great purity.”

2005 Standish Shiraz- “extraordinary elegance, richness and nuance from 90 year old vines. 32 months in oak; abundant blueberry and crème de cassis notes with flavors of flowers and graphite.” *Robert Parker rated.*

'04 Jayson” Firm, ripe and complex, with vivid red currant and black cherry fruit...Merlot, Cabernet, Franc and Petite Verdot” *92 pts Wine Spectator*

From the renowned winemaking team of Sparky and Sarah Marquis (*94 and 91 pts Robert Parker*) ‘Big red’. 2006 - “Tightly wound with intense, spicy black fruit flavors, full-bodied, and superb balance.” 2007 - “Big, ripe and focused, offering a blast of cherry and plum...long, vivid finish.”

14. 1990 Vevue Clicquot La Grand Dame

One of the truly great individual bottlings from Champagne. Magnificent “assertive and buttery-style, dry and bold in flavors, but with the lively effervescence and toasty finish for balance.” *95 pts Robert Parker*

15. 2002 Perrier-Jouet Fleur de Champagne Brut Rose Belle Epoque

Top-of-the-line French Brut Rose - 55% Pinot Noir and 45% Chardonnay.

16. 2000 Chateau Pavie, Premier Grand Cru Classe St Emilion

Is this “The Perfect Wine”? Robert Parker gave it a Perfect 100!! “It is unquestionably one of the most monumental wines Bordeaux has ever produced. The color is opaque purple, and the bouquet offers up notes of liquid minerals, blackberries, cherries, and cassis intermixed. 19. 1998 Zind-Humbrecht Pinot Gris Vendange Tardive

22. 1995 Quinta do Vesuvio Porto

Simply legendary single vineyard (Quinta) Oporto made from selected 52 pipes from over 385 pipes made.

23. 2003 Chateau La Tour Blanche, Sauterne

24. Pair- 2003 Dominio de Bierzo Bim Bi Bre, Spain

Big-Time stuff ! “This red achieves elegance with power; a seamless, silky wine with harmonious blackberry, plum, licorice, mineral and floral notes with integrated tannins. Best thru 2012.”

25. Pair- 2001 Delas Cote-Rotie Seigneur de Maugiron

Classic Rhone 'Cote-Rotie'. “Captivating aromas of game and iron along with lots of silky sanguine, dark plum, roasted coffee bean and sweet earth flavors. Elegant, smoky finish.” *90 pts Wine Spectator*

26. Pair - 2001 Marcarini Barolo La Serra

Beautiful mature single vineyard Barolo; “Very perfumed on the nose...full-bodied with fine tannins and a long silky finish. Best after 2008.” *91pts Wine Spectator*
